2. Competitors who have not yet finalised payment details are required to contact the entries secretary, Trisha Hogan, before Friday 27th July to arrange payment.

5. Mechanical Scrutiny is located at EARS Motorsport in Quartertown Industrial Estate Mallow on Friday July 27th 2018. A google map link has been provided on the Jim Walsh Cork Forest Rally Facebook page and www.corkmotorclub.com illustrating the location.
Scrutiny opens at 18:00 and closes at 21:00 sharp –Please be on time.
Please Note: Time schedule for Saturday Morning Mechanical Scrutiny as published in the event regulations, is now changed from 07:30 to 09:00 and is available on a limited basis. Saturday scrutiny must be pre-arranged with the COC – Paul Casey-0868050710 or paulowencasey@gmail.com
6. Documentation scrutiny takes place on Friday July 27th from **18:30 to 21:30** and Saturday 28th from **07:45 to 09:15** sharp. Documentation scrutiny is located in the Cork County Council offices adjacent to Parc Ferme. Please be on time and have all relevant documentation to hand – No IRDS/BRDS and or Licence – No Start

7. The trailer park, documentation scrutiny and Parc Ferme are all located at The Cork County Council offices at Annabella Mallow. Please enter through the Dairygold roundabout off the N20. This will be arrowed. Again please see the google map link. Due to the size of the entry received this year we also have an overflow trailer park located at Mallow RFC Rugby Club, on the east side of the town. Please work with the marshals to ensure all trailers are parked as neatly as possible in each of the trailer parks.

All cars must be in Parc Ferme by 10am sharp on Saturday July 28th – no exceptions.

8. Please note that there will be NO service between Parc Ferme Out Control and the Arrival Control of SS1 on Saturday July 28th. All cars must be ready to start the event before being placed in Parc Ferme – please ensure that you have adequate fuel and tyres to complete the first 2 stages and the associated road sections. (53.9km total road section + 17.2km total stage)
9. The Saturday service area is located in Mitchelstown Business Park, Mitchelstown Co Cork (see event google map link). The Saturday service area will open at 10am on Saturday July 28th. All service vehicles must display their service sticker – no sticker no access. The Sunday service area is located in the Dairygold Contractor Car Park on Park Road Mallow. The Sunday service area will be open from 18:00 on Saturday July 28th. Ground sheets must be used in both service areas at all times – no ground sheet – no service. Please work with and cooperate with our marshals in the service areas.
10. Detailed A3 sized route maps will be available to competitors to purchase at documentation scrutiny.
11. Applications for reseeding must be submitted at documentation scrutiny on Friday July 27th by no later than 21:00 – **no applications for reseed will be accepted after this time or on Saturday morning – if you wish to apply for a reseed – you must apply on the Friday night.** Applications must be made on the official reseeding application forms available at documentation scrutiny.
12. Competitors safety briefing will take place at 10:30 on Saturday July 28th at the Fire Station adjacent to Parc Ferme – please be on time.
13. First Car away from MC1 on Saturday July 28th is 11:31 – a starters list and times will be published in Parc Ferme on the morning of the event.
14. The official notice board will be located in documentation scrutiny on Friday July 27th and the Rally HQ – The Hibernian Hotel for the remainder of the event.
